APPOINTMENT OF NON-EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Austal Limited (Austal) (ASX: ASB) is pleased to announce the appointment of Lee Goddard as a Non-Executive Director of the Company.

Mr Goddard is currently the Chief Executive Officer of the Australian Missile Corporation and a Non-Executive Director of the Commonwealth Superannuation Corporation.

Prior to these roles, he had a distinguished full-time naval career in the Royal Australian Navy (RAN) spanning 34 years, concluding his tenure in 2021 as a Rear Admiral.

Among his achievements as a leader in the RAN, he was dual appointed as Commander of the Joint Agency Taskforce 'Operation Sovereign Borders' and as Commander, Maritime Border Command.

Mr Goddard will commence as a Non-Executive Director of Austal on 1 January 2023, and his appointment follows the resignation of Giles Everist as Non-Executive Director on 9 December 2022.

Austal Chair John Rothwell said he was delighted to welcome Mr Goddard to the Company.

"Lee's breadth and depth of naval defence industry expertise, in addition to his extensive international defence industry networks, aligns perfectly with Austal's strategic direction," Mr Rothwell said.
